

# Uploading Progress

A separate page has been created to track the process of unloading files

1. Click on the "Upload" tab
2. Here you can set the number of files to be uploaded at the same time
3. Here you can set the number of times the task will try to restart in case of an error
4. This is the list of current upload tasks
5. Button for clearing successfully executed tasks
6. Button for clearing tasks with errors
7. Button to stop all active or pending tasks
8. The button for a forced restart of all tasks with errors
9. The list of links corresponds to the list of successful unloading tasks
10. The switch allows in the text field (9) instead of splitting links into multiple lines, but to separate them with a space, without splitting.
